

# ***WHERE THE FLOCK AM I?***

## **St. Louis Park Flock Scavenger Hunt**

### **Instructions**

- Goal: Locate, in real life, as many Flock cameras within St. Louis Park as you can.
- How to win:
  - Earn points by locating Flock cams. Public (city-owned) ones are required to end the game, but private ones will earn bonuses.
  - The game ends when all public cams are located, or after a reasonable time period, as determined by us, elapses.
  - Only public Flock cameras
- To record your points: Send us an email at [eyesoffslp@proton.me](mailto:eyesoffslp@proton.me) including the following proof:
  - Text description of camera location (as listed by BCA, or even more specific).
  - A photo of the camera and the surroundings. A screenshot of a pin on your map may help too.
- Scores will be recorded based on time of email receipt. We will keep a public leaderboard where you can show off to your friends, and track the progress of others, and receive game updates.
- **Do not damage or vandalize these cameras while playing this game.**
- **Do not trespass onto private property to locate these cameras. All cameras should either be on public right-of-way or able to be photographed from public ROW.**

### **Locating Flock Cameras**

- As per state law, the BCA maintains a list of all fixed ALPR locations deployed within MN: <https://dps.mn.gov/divisions/bca/data-and-reports/agencies-use-lprs-lpr>
- Private cameras are not listed by any authoritative source. See the next tip about mapping websites.
- Crowdsourced mapping websites may assist you with locating Flock cams more precisely. Exact locations may be out of date or no longer valid.
